THE BIBLICAL TIME LINE OF KING DAVID

The Biblical Calendar will show David became King over Israel in, Earth 10006 Years; and that David was 30 when he became king. Therefore, 10006 – 30 = Earth 9976 Years, or, 1030 B.C., as the year of David's birth. How the Biblical Calendar of David begins is proven by the following. Four hundred and eighty years, [480], after the Exodus, (1 Kings 6:1), God declares Solomon to be in his fourth year reign over Israel as coregent with his father David, who has reigned 40 years at this time, and who is 70. The fourth year of Solomon's reign is the same year David dies, in, Earth 10046 Years. Because David reigned forty, [40], years over Israel, (2 Samuel 5:4), David's reign over Israel begins in, Earth 10006 Years, [10046 – 40 = 10006]. Because David was thirty, [30], when he began reigning over Israel, (2 Samuel 5:4), David must have been born in, Earth 9976 Years, [10006 – 30 = 9976]. Thus, David, a man after God's own heart, who shall fulfill all of God's will, according to the flesh, at 30, may begin a 1000 year generation to the virgin birth of Jesus Christ; 'Earth 11006 Years', or, 1 A.D., [once understood as, 7 B.C.]. NOTE: All of the preceding gospel years, [B.C.], have been adjusted by 7 full years from the late Brother Camping's original calendar.

These truths have a lot to do with how the reigns of Judah and Israel correctly tie together as an accurate biblical calendar. In truth, the Assession Year System, by which the years of kings reigns are counted from the first full year of the reign began with the reign of Saul, the first king of Israel.

She was actually the daughter of Ahab. Omri began his 1st year reign over Israel 42 years earlier, in, 877 B.C. Ahaziah began his reign over Judah in 835 B.C. Through his mother, Athaliah, Ahaziah is a 42 year old blood line, son, of Omri's dynasty when Ahaziah begins to reign in Judah. Thus, the forty and two years.

Ahaziah going to help his brother, [by blood], King Joram of Israel, is killed by Jehu, and Joram is killed also.

Ahaziah, the son of Jehoram, the son of Jehoshaphat, [Judah], was not a good king of Judah. Ahaziah had been corrupted by his mother, Athaliah, so that he thought and did as king Ahab of Israel would have done – Ahab being the father of Athaliah, who is Ahaziah's mother. It appears, by the wishes of Athaliah, [Ahaziah's mother], that Ahaziah's marching orders were to make Judah like wicked Israel. When Ahaziah is killed by Jehu, [Israel], who is working directly for God in eliminating the dynasty of Ahab, Athaliah, [confederate with wicked Israel], quickly moves to destroy all the royals of Judah in order to complete the goal of making Judah as wicked Israel – not having one good king. An apparent contradiction is resolved when we recognize that Jehoiakim made his eight (8) year old son coregent with himself almost immediately after Jehoiakim ascended the thrown. In 602 B.C., Jehoiakim began to reign. The next year, 601 B.C., his eight (8) year old son, Jehoiachin, was made co-regent with Jehoiakim. Ten (10) years later in 591 B.C. is when Jehoiachin is 18 years old who was already reigning when his father Jehoiakim who was taken to Babylon. After Jehoiachin reigns for only Three months and days he is also taken to Babylon.
