

**Christ is the power of God
and the Wisdom of God:**

1 Corinthians 1:24 But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God.

**Christ the power of God
is wiser than mankind:**

1 Corinthians 1:25 Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

**God does not call many wise many
mighty many noble after the flesh:**

1 Corinthians 1:26 For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called:

**God chooses the foolish and weak of the flesh
to confound the wise and mighty of the flesh:**

1 Corinthians 1:27 But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty;

**God chooses the humble and despised and
rejected to bring forth that which is approved
so that there is no boasting in His presence:**

1 Corinthians 1:28 And base, [humble], things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: 29 That no flesh should glory in his presence.

**Christ Jesus is our Wisdom, Righteousness, and
Sanctification, and Redemption in Whom we Glory:**

1 Corinthians 1:30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: 31 That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord.
