Is mankind unaware of God's judgment and coming wrath?

Not according to the scriptures, and the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ, (1 Corinthians 15:3-4).

In, Romans 1:18-20, the word of God is clear and unambiguous about mankind's awareness of God's judgment and coming wrath:

Romans 1:18-20 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; 19 ¶ Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. 20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

In, 2 Peter 2:5, God also declares:

2 Peter 2:5 And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

What potent statements God is making here, as Holy men of old, [His elect], were moved by God so that these statements and many others would be documented, that God's people might see the Truth as it comes from the Creator God, and Him alone, (2 Peter 1:20-21).

PART 2

As in all of scripture, however, we either believe with the whole heart what God says, or we don't. Yet, whatever we believe, God's eternal word shall stand:

Proverbs 19:21 ¶ There are many devices in a man's heart; nevertheless, the counsel of the LORD, that shall stand.

So, we may see two profound statements God is showing us, which are found in, Romans 1:18-20, and, 2 Peter 2:5, where God is making it clear, that all mankind, [of themselves], in the recesses of their hearts and minds, [before they might be

saved], know of God judgment and coming wrath, [not His salvation and forgiveness]. In other words, Romans 1:18-20, is a PRECEPT, that is speaking of ALL MANKIND prior to any becoming born again, (Psalm 14:2-3; Romans 3:10).

As God also reveals, Noah's preaching of God's righteousness, and the Godly fear that led Noah to the building of the Ark, would only be received by Noah and his house. Though the world of that day saw the building of the Ark, and heard the righteous peaching of Noah, they were not moved to repent of their sins before Holy God, [like Nineveh was]. "SO, DID THEY NOT KNOW?"

Psalm 14:4-5 ¶ Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people as they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD. 5 There were they in great fear: for God is in the generation of the righteous.

Hebrews 11:7 By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.

PART 3

So, IT IS NOT, our preaching of the gospel, whether it be of the goodness of God, or whether it be of His coming wrath, "that moves anyone to repent", but those God has ordained to salvation who will hear and believe; because the Spirit of Christ is drawing them, (John 6:44). Subsequently, according to the scriptures, if we are going to be found preaching, THUS SAITH THE LORD, it had better be, THE WHOLE COUNSEL OF GOD; or, it is ANOTHER GOSPEL.

For example: scare tactics and having the spiritual attitude that because we're so close to the end, WE THEREFORE HAVE TO GET THE ATTENTION of the world that judgment day is coming, [according to time lines and God's wrath]. However, the bible clearly shows how this, IS GOD'S JOB NOT OURS, (1 Corinthians 3:6).

This scare tactic attitude also dismisses, THE TRUTH, that for every individual on this earth, and at any time in its history, individual mankind is ALWAYS CLOSE TO THE END; by virtue

of the fact that the amount of years we might live is literally, NOTHING, when compared to eternity where God abides:

James 4:14 Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away.

And none of us knows how many years their going to live, before the end of this life arrives, as the world news corporations witnesses every single day.

PART 4

According to all of scripture, the believers calling is to preach the gospel, IN ITS ENTIRETY; WHETHER THEY HEAR OR WHETHER THEY FORBEAR, (Ezekiel 3:11), leaving out nothing, nor isolating any of God's word, like what Satan did with Jesus in the wilderness, (Matthew 4:1-11).

Therefore, with respect to God's commandments in its entirety, [the whole counsel of God], there are many conclusions God reveals to us from His word, that harmonizes and manifests the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. One of these commandments is found in, Matthew 28:19-20:

Matthew 28:19-20 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: 20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

If, However, we find, that, verses like, Matthew 28:19-20, is no longer part of God's Holy word, TO US TODAY, as the commandments, WE ARE TO KEEP, (Psalm 119), according to the salvation of the Lord Jesus Christ, it must be, ANOTHER GOSPEL WE ARE FOLLOWING, which is NOT according to the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ, (2 Corinthians 11:4)!

How beautiful, then, is ALL OF GOD'S WORD:

Psalm 119:97 \P O how love I thy law! it is my meditation all the day.
