O House of David!

Isaiah 7:13-16 And he said, Hear ye now, O house of David; Is it a small thing for you to weary men, but will ye weary my God also? 14 <u>Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin</u> <u>shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel</u>. 15 Butter and honey shall he eat, that he may know to refuse the evil, and choose the good. 16 For before the child shall know to refuse the evil, and choose the good, the land that thou abhorrest shall be forsaken of both her kings.

Old Testament Israel becomes two houses divided for a gin and for a snare; but in David is one house, manifesting Christ and His people chosen by God

1 Kings 11:11-13 Wherefore the LORD said unto Solomon, Forasmuch as this is done of thee, and thou hast not kept my covenant and my statutes, which I have commanded thee, I will surely rend the kingdom from thee, and will give it to thy servant. 12 <u>Notwithstanding in thy days I will not do it for David thy father's</u> <u>sake</u>: but I will rend it out of the hand of thy son. 13 <u>Howbeit I will</u> <u>not rend away all the kingdom; but will give one tribe to thy son for</u> <u>David my servant's sake, and for Jerusalem's sake which I have</u> <u>chosen</u>.

A New Testament Israel is now two houses divided

Luke 12:51-56 Suppose ye that I am come to give peace on earth? I tell you, Nay; but rather division: 52 For from henceforth there shall be five in one house divided, three against two, and two against three. ... 54 ¶ And he said also to the people, When ye see a cloud rise out of the west, straightway ye say, There cometh a shower; and so it is. 55 And when ye see the south wind blow, ye say, There will be heat; and it cometh to pass. 56 <u>Ye hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky and of the earth; but how is it that ye do not discern this time</u>?

Mark 3:23-26 And he called them unto him, and said unto them in parables, How can Satan cast out Satan? 24 <u>And if a kingdom be</u> <u>divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. 25 And if a house</u> <u>be divided against itself, that house cannot stand</u>. 26 And if Satan rise up against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but hath an end.
