

The Bible alone is Truth

The penalty of judgment removed.
Assurance and Trust in God regained.

John 5:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

Romans 8:1 ¶ There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Romans 8:16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

1 John 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. 18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. 19 We love him, because he first loved us.

God's word the Bible can reveal how it is God alone in Jesus Christ who makes the sinner spiritually clean:

Psalms 119:11 ¶ Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.

John 15:3 Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.

God's word the Bible can reveal the freedom of the Father's Holy Son in us, who, through the Holy Spirit, works to keep us from slavery to sin as well as providing us with wisdom and power to successfully mortify the deeds of the flesh:

John 8:34-36 Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin. 35 And the servant abideth not in the house for ever: but the Son abideth ever. 36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

Romans 6:18-23 Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness. 19 I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness. 20 For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness. 21 What fruit had ye

then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. 22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. 23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Colossians 3:1-2 ¶ If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. 2 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

God's Living Word documented in the Holy Bible gives importance and purpose to life that perpetually motivates His elect to serve their Lord, according to the scriptures.

1 Peter 2:7-10 Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner, 8 And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed. 9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light: 10 Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.

All of these things God's Living Word speaks to His own is their daily experience in life; for they are a new creation, born again, born from above. It is now a growing in grace that separates them from the past bitterness and regrets of their previous life and the old man:

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

A new creation does not manifest perfection in the flesh. All of ones favorite sins are not necessarily instantly gone with their temptations and trials. But a new spiritual attitude has begun to grow that can never die. An attitude that is utterly miserable if it cannot serve the Lord Jesus Christ and Him first before self, according to the scriptures. In an ongoing mortifying of the flesh, there is a true and undeniable growing in grace that ultimately overcomes all obstacles; for every sin has been forgiven, past, present, and future. So we strive to enter in because it is the way God in Christ has designed our new life to manifest on the sin cursed earth, so that the world shall be without excuse.

Galatians 6:15 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.

Hebrews 10:15-18 Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before, 16 This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; 17 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. 18 Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin.

Believers who are truly born again, born from above, have a new life whereby they become able to sacrifice for others. Not as a necessary work that others might see, but from the Love of God who now abides in them eternally, according to His Will and Good Pleasure.

We grow to overcome our fears because we now rest in the Lord and not rather in our own vain hope that somehow things will work out if we keep working at it, when they never did before, but we were too blind to see, or accept.

Those who trust in the living word of God documented in the Holy Bible know the promises of God are more than just poetry, or things to make mankind feel better, as the world alleges. To the believers who are the body of Christ, God's promises are true. They testify to the heart and soul that the believers trust in the Bible is not erroneous or vain, but a manifestation of God's mercy and love to His own now and forever more. It is not about their perfectly presented faith on the sin cursed earth. It is about the perfect unfolding of God's mercy and love for His elect who ultimately see death as gain, and life on this earth as an opportunity to witness the gospel of Jesus Christ, according to the scriptures:

1 Corinthians 15:3-4 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; 4 And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:
