By His Faithfulness we can have Peace with God

Romans 5:1-6 ¶ Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: 2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. 3 And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; 4 And patience, experience; and experience, hope: 5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. 6 ¶ For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.

By His Faithfulness we can escape the corruption of this world

2 Peter 1:3-8 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: 4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. 5 ¶ And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; 6 And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; 7 And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity. 8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

By His Faithfulness we can Feed His sheep:

The world performs its tests based on how it sees the way they should sound and look to themselves; the outside of the cup. God's people examine themselves, internally, based on the spiritual word of God. If the powers show to be in us but still growing, we feed the sheep. We rejoice to nurture the power we see growing, not the imperfections. If one falls the brother or the sister will lift the other up. The devils' children only rejoice to steal, kill, and destroy. This is how God tells us we can know the spirit of God next to the spirit of the world (1 Co 2:12-13).

**By His Faithfulness we can know
we are hearing God rather than man**

1 Corinthians 2:11-13 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

No one ultimately knows me, but myself and God who's Holy Spirit knows all things.

1 Corinthians 2:12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

No one ultimately knows the truths of God, which are contrary to the spirit of the world, but those who have been freely given the Spirit of God, so that their desire is to read His word continually.

1 Corinthians 2:13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

No one ultimately speaks the words of God faithfully, but through the Holy Ghost who teaches them what to speak; which is according to the scripture we call THE HOLY BIBLE. What the Holy Bible teaches in its entirety is what the devils' children will always work to discredit. They do this by, (1), isolating verses from its context, and, (2), adding ideas to verses which the language, [English], clearly doesn't show. The only way to know this is happening is when we become totally familiar with all of God's word the Bible, as the Lord instructs us:

Joshua 1:8 This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17 That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.
